Broken relationships are the result of unpaid debts.

I. RELATIONSHIP ACCOUNTS

“whoever has a complaint against anyone”

- A. **CREDITS**: Words and actions that build. 3:12
- B. **DEBITS**: Words and actions that destroy. 3:5,8
- C. **DEBTS**: What must be paid to restore value.

Assignment: Make a list of what you believe
is owed to you to clear the debt.

- D. **BANKRUPTCY**: Refusing to pay.

II. GOSPEL ACCOUNTING

“just as the Lord forgave you.”

3:13; John 14:27, 20:21-23, II Corinthians 5:11

- A. **GOD** will settle all accounts
- B. We have a huge **DEBT**.
- C. We are promised a large **INHERITANCE**
- D. It cost the **DEATH** of the benefactor.
- E. The will is in effect: you have been given **PEACE**.
- F. **WE** are to act according to the terms of the Will.
- G. The **HOLY SPIRIT** has been appointed as executor.
