I. The **ASSERTION**:

Jesus is God: The king of heaven and earth.

Matthew 26:64-65, Mark 14:62, Luke 22:70

TASK: Go Tell people that Jesus is King.

COST: Everything

PROMISE: You won't finish the task before the SON of MAN comes.

II. The **CHALLENGE**:

Jesus was wrong about being God,
but he was a GOOD TEACHER.
CS Lewis: Russel, Schweitzer, Gandhi

II. The ANSWER:

The meaning of "words"

The Son of Man Comes: **CORONATION**

Daniel 7: 13-14, Psalm 118, Zechariah 9

Clouds: <u>PRESENCE</u> and <u>AUTHORITY</u> (Matthew 26:64-65)

The <u>TIMING</u> of fulfillment.

Matthew 27:51, 28:18, Hebrews 6:19, 9:11-12, 24

The <u>CONCLUSION</u>: Jesus can be trusted:
 He was crowned king and sits on his throne just as he promised.
