- a. **God will be very pleased with your proactivity. WHY**
 - The provident grace of God does not preclude the prudent diligence of man.
- b. **God will put you in a position where you will have to choose**
whether or not you will pursue Him and His ways.
 - **RAHAB** The place where you will stand.
- c. **Your choices after that point will become like a FAITH DANCE**
 - Discerning the **SOVEREIGN PLEASURE** of God.
- d. **Critical people** will question your **CHOICES** and your **MOTIVES**.
- e. **God will honor you and your choice to pursue Him,**
even when your motives are **MIXED**.
