Matthew 4:1-11 September 13, 2020

I. He **STAYED** on **SCRIPT**ure.

The Father stays with the Script: Matthew 17:5
The Son stays with the Script: John 5:19-47
The Holy Spirit stays with the script: John 16:13

II. He **SUBMITTED** to the Scripture.

Matthew 4:4

Signs of deviation:

It's all about me: Turning Stones into Bread
 It's all about them: Jumping from the Temple
 It's all about now: Compromised Worship

III. He **STUDIED** the whole Scripture.

Matthew 4:7

Signs of a sect:

- Isolated Scripture
- Idolatrous People
- Insulated Thought

IV. He **STOOD** on the Scripture.

Matthew 4:10

- Unlikely Character
- Unwavering Confidence
- Uncharacteristic Courage
