I. **DON'T BE SURPRISED BY EVIL.**

- It's not about AGE
(Or ability, commitment, knowledge, etc.)
- It is about PREPAREDNESS for battle.

B. **PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE**

- HONEST ASSESSMENT
- INTENTIONAL ABIDING
