Forgiveness, and the need for it, is the epicenter of events in life and eternity.

FORGIVENESS IS . . .

- A punishment pardoned.
- A debt canceled.
- A relationship restored.

Forgiveness is granted as a favor to the offender by the one who has been offended. Forgiveness is never earned and cannot be demanded.

Forgiveness takes place in the heart of the one who has been offended first as they respond to God in prayer.

How forgiveness is applied in the life of the offender is dependent upon their response.
